The coordinators will also work closely with our partner, the Raspberry Pi Foundation to support the delivery of a two-year partnership in computing curriculum, teacher training and related teaching and learning activities.

- Deliver training modules, using training materials provided by the Raspberry Pi Foundation.
- Adapt training programs to meet the needs of educators, including the use of application of Culturally Relevant Pedagogy (CRP)
- Be familiar with products offered by RPF by completing any necessary preparation, including completing online courses.
- Utilise a variety of instructional methods, techniques, and technologies to engage participants and enhance learning outcomes.
- Engage in ongoing professional development with the Raspberry Pi Foundation.
- Provide ongoing support and guidance to educators through coaching, mentoring, and resource-sharing initiatives.
- Maintain accurate records of training activities, attendance, and participant progress.
- Work with the Raspberry Pi Foundation to evaluate the effectiveness of training programs through participant feedback, assessment data, and performance metrics.
